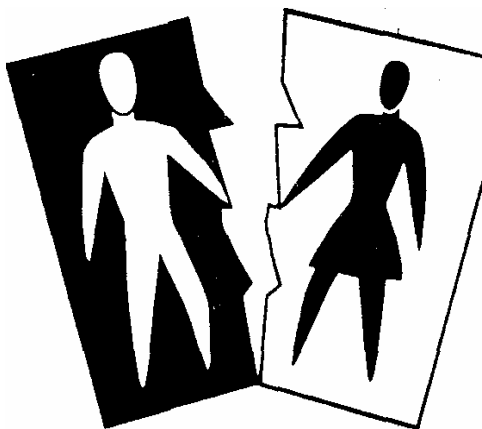


ARE YOU IN AN ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIP?
